• Describes in detail knowledge gained or new skills developed as a result of his/her 4-H experiences					
• Illustrates a deep reflection of personal “growth” as a result of his/her 4-H experiences					
• Both written reflection and additional support pages with visual representations exist					
• Includes reflections for 4-H Activities, each 4-H project, 4-H demo, service-learning, and youth leadership.

• Both are included and complete with all necessary parts, as appropriate					
• Goals are thoughtful and realistic for 4-H member					
• Financials are appropriate for member’s age and include record of income and expenses for each 4-H project
