Dear Cloverbud Family,

We are writing today with the schedule and some additional information about the Cloverbud judging process at the Jackson County Fair.

<u>The judging takes place on Thursday, August 1st in the Milt Lunda Memorial Arena</u>. Each youth is assigned a judging time. If the assigned time does not work for you, please come later during the time designated as "Open for Late Entries." Contact me if neither time works for your Cloverbud youth.

Cloverbuds do not need to check in their projects early. They will bring their projects to the judges' table and talk face-to-face with the judge about their project, what they did, what they got help with, and their overall experience.

We're also including a Cloverbud Card that you can print, add a photo of the youth to and have them fill out with their own personal information. The card will be placed with the youth's projects so fair-goers can read about the youth exhibitors too. Paper copies will be available at the Fair.

Finally, we will have copies of the Cloverbud Record Books on hand at the Fair for Cloverbuds interested in keeping a record of their year. You can also find them on the 4-H webpage at <a href="https://jackson.extension.wisc.edu/4-h/for-members-and-parents/record-book/">https://jackson.extension.wisc.edu/4-h/for-members-and-parents/record-book/</a>. It's under Forms on that page. The deadline to turn in record books is September 1st. Cloverbuds will receive feedback about completed record books and will be recognized with a certificate during the annual banquet later this year.

Remember to put the Cloverbud's name on their Fair item(s)! You may pick up exhibits after 4:30 p.m. on Aug 4th.
