Please check out some important information below regarding the 4-H program - we have some new, exciting things ahead of us! - **Fair Related Questions** - If you have any fair related questions, or entry tag questions you need to reach out to the Fair Office. The Jackson County Fair is an event that is put on by the Fair Board and they are kind enough to have our 4-H youth participate. The Fair Board is the final decision in rules, policies, etc. You can reach them by calling 715-299-4137
- **Cloverbud/Explorer Judging** - 2019 judging for Cloverbuds and Explorers for the Jackson County Fair takes place on Thursday, August 1st in the Milt Lunda Memorial Arena. - **Summer of Science (SOS)** - Get your STEM fix this summer by participating in events starting July 1st. Try cool experiments and activities with Mad Science Mondays, which are held weekly until August 5th. Bring out your inner inventor with Club Tech Days, day camps meant to explore technology and robotics (please note there is a small registration fee for the day camps to help cover costs). Programs are open to both 4-H and community youth and include a wide range of ages!

- **Record books** - We are excited that Record Books are right around the corner! We have many options on how to make a 4-H record book, so choose what fits your style to share what your 4-H story has been over the course of this past year. We recognize that there are different ways that youth like to do things and that there are different ways to put together a Record Book that will best represent the youth and their experience in the 4-H program that year. Also, it should be noted that you can still do the 'Traditional Record Book' as well if you'd like to—that option has not gone away!

  - Fall Forum takes place on November 1-3, 2019! We would LOVE to take a large delegation to the forum this year to help our youth gain valuable leadership skills!

- **Jackson County 4-H Extension Website**- We have re-vamped the 4-H website to make it more user-friendly! - **Wisconsin Waiver for Pullorum Testing for Poultry at Fair** - The law requiring pullorum testing for "persons who use poultry or farm-raised game birds or their eggs for breeding or hatching or for the exhibition at a fair or livestock exhibition" has been waived as of April 22, 2019. The waiver will remain until it is determined that pullorum antigen is sufficiently available. It is unclear when that date may be. This update is from the State of Wisconsin.
  - What this means: Poultry can be shown at the fair without testing this year—at least until new antigen becomes available. Notification will be sent if more antigen has become available and if it is needed to be shown at fair this year.
- **4-H Cook Book Recipes Needed** - The Parent and Leaders Association is working to create a Jackson County 4-H Cook Book as a fundraiser that will be filled with recipes from YOU! **We are looking to get ONE recipe from**

- **4-H Awards** - Recognition is important and we want to be sure that our youth, parents, and volunteers are being recognized and thanked for all of the amazing work that they do! To figure out the awards for the banquet, we gather information from club leaders and 4-Hers!
  - All award materials are emailed, and mailed if requested, to the 4-H Club leaders in the beginning of August.
  - Starting in 2019, we have moved the awards materials online. Club leaders are tasked with ensuring that all awards material is completed and submitted to the Jackson County Extension office **by Friday, September 13, 2019!**
