2020 Wisconsin 4-H Quiz Bowl and Skillathon Results

(Madison, WI) The Wisconsin 4-H Quiz Bowl and Skillathon contests were both held on Saturday, March 7 at the University of Wisconsin Madison Animal Sciences Building. Livestock Quiz Bowl, in its 16th year, is a competition where questions are about beef, sheep, swine and meat goat topics and students use a buzzer in order to answer. Teams compete in a double elimination format by giving oral answers to questions posed by a judge. Each match has both an individual and toss-up question round. A group discussion round is included in the senior division to simulate the national competition.

The Senior Quiz Bowl winner represents Wisconsin at the National 4-H Quiz Bowl contest at the North American International Livestock Exposition in Louisville, KY in November. The winning team of the senior division (14 years of age or older) was Jackson County. Members included: Kaden Moseley, Trent Laufenberg, Grace Kling, Wyatt Berg, and Austin Laufenberg.

Second place in Senior Quiz Bowl went to Polk County: Members were: Katherine Elwood, Grace Haase, Courtney Glenna, and Courtney Stream.

Winner of the Junior Quiz Bowl division (under 14 years old) was Jackson County 1. Members included Jack Laufenburg, Luke Fischer, Jake Kling, Austin Olson, and Doyle Hagen.

Second place went to Jackson County 2. Members included: Morgan Lindow, Amara Streff, Morgan Berg, Brenna Thorson, and Alyssa Lindow.

Winner of the Mixed division (must contain at least one youth from each age division) was Sheboygan County A. Team members included: Alisha Klemme, Ethan Kohlman, Cloe Bruenig, and Alison Gartman.

Juneau County A was second place. Members included: Dawson Firlus, Dravan Robinson, Gabby Wohlrab, and Tyler Schwartz.

In the Skillathon contest, participants complete a 25 question written test, 4 individual skill-a-thon stations where contestants take part in livestock breed identification, feed identification, equipment identification and meat identification. The final portion is the team exercises where each team works together to best solve 4 different scenarios involving live animals and animal management concepts. This phase helps youth learn problem solving, critical thinking and teamwork.

The winning 4-H Skillathon team was from Grant County and will represent Wisconsin at the National 4-H Skillathon Contest in Louisville, KY in November. Second place senior team was Jackson County which included: Kaden Moseley, Trent Laufenberg, Grace Kling, Wyatt Berg, and Austin Laufenberg.



We use it often for state wide meetings so I can walk you through the use of it.

4-H Camp Updates

With our recent merge into UW– Madison there has been a couple of policy updates that will affect our programing. As of this year we have to complete a intent to camp form and are encouraged to use certified camp facilities. This effects the Jackson County camp program in a number of ways. It will change where we camp, how we plan it, how we feed campers and how we respond to emergencies that can happen during the camp program. This does not mean we will not have a camp, it just means we have a couple more rules to follow in order to keep up with the University's wishes.

This year the Buffalo, Pepin, Peirce and Trempealeau County camp Partnership have invited Jackson County Youth to participate in Camp Kinnisippewa up in Marie on St, Croix Minnesota. This camp would be larger then Jackson County previously was but youth would get the opportunity to meet youth from around our area. **Dates are June 29-July 1st.**

The cost is \$125 per camper and that includes meals for 3 days, lodging, transportation, and program materials. There is a possibility for P&L support.

To register you have to login to 4-H Online. Registration is first come first serve and it is open until April 15th. It is currently open now.

I wanted to extend this invitation to the youth in the county so that we can keep summer camp in Jackson County.
