Background Information:

The internship position will offer a wide range of learning experiences with meaningful, professional-level experiences to the student. Job Description:

Program-specific activities in the internship will be involved include the following:

- Coordinate and assist with summer agriculture programs including on-farm field day(s), pasture walks, horticulture education series for Jackson County Boys and Girls Club at the community garden, and local food promotion efforts.
- Promote, market, and deliver the "Summer of Science" program, including assistance and support for the summer camp program.
- Develop vital, sustainable communication and outreach tools to recruit and retain first-generation 4-H youth and families.
- Develop and communicate program outreach materials.
- Prepare and coordinate program resources and logistics.
- Assist Extension Educators with program instruction.
- Support Extension certified volunteers.
- Work with local educators on needs assessment including data entry and analysis.

- Ability to be self-directed and self-motivated.
- Ability to communicate and cooperate with a team.
- Interest in working directly with youth and adults.
- Competency in social media and Microsoft/Google platforms.
- Reliable transportation and ability to work nights and weekends.
