VIP Training:

VIP or Volunteers in Preparation training is for anyone who wants to work with youth one-on-one and teach sessions like a project or club leader. If you have signed up to be a volunteer in 4-H Online and I have yet to approve you, it is because of this. You must complete either VIP (in-person Training), mandated reporter training (Online), or Titel IX Training (Online). I will shift towards less pre-scheduled VIP training and more to working with your schedule. I am also willing to come to club meetings and training adults there! Please contact Andrea if you are interested in scheduling a VIP training!

The mandated reporter is an online course in 4-H Online that you can complete on time. VIP, however, has to be taught by either myself or another educator virtually or in person. This training covers topics like creating a safe environment for youth, insurance, what to do in an emergency, and more. It takes about 90 minutes.

I prefer to do VIP training on weeknights in September-May because the rest of the year gets pretty busy for everyone, especially in the summer.
